VR&E's Vocational Rehabilitation Counselors will work one on one with you to complete a plan specifically tailored to your needs and designed to help you achieve your goals.



We can help you find a job that matches your existing skills. We placed over 10,000 Veterans into new positions in Fiscal Year 2022!



If you're interested in exploring a new field, we can help you determine your next step and provide the right education or training to get you started. Some options that are available include degree programs, certificates, apprenticeships, and on the job training.



We pay tuition, fees, books, and supplies for viable approved programs along with a monthly allowance.



We can help you successfully return to a civilian job you held before you were deployed.



We can help you start your own business.



We can help certain Veterans with a serious employment handicap get home modifications made to help them live more independently.

VR&E empowers you to take the next step in your career. If you're a service member or Veteran and have a service-connected disability that limits your ability to work, you may be eligible for VR&E services.
