Chief Keene shared the Q2 FY23-24 San Mateo County Juvenile Services and Institutions Dashboard.

- Our diversion caseload numbers are increasing. We are continuing to partner with schools and police partners to place more youth on diversion and prevent entry into the juvenile justice system.

B. Comments & Updates

- The community partners here today have their own programs, and we work closely to offer diversion opportunities that prevent young people from entering the system. We believe that if we can divert young people from the system, even from Probations Diversion program, they have a much better chance of not being a part of the criminal justice system.

- Chief Keene reported that there are no budget updates. In terms of money, there are conversations in the legislative cycle around redirecting some funds to other venues. Chief Keene will share all the information with the group in the coming months.
